Dear Parents / Carers,

Macbeth and Othello will be visiting the Imperial War Museum on Friday 18th January 2019. This is part of our new topic on A Child's War, during our visit we will be investigating what life was like for evacuees and other children during World War 2.

There is no cost for this trip, although it is essential the below permission slip is returned to the office.

We will be travelling to the museum by train and we will be leaving school promptly at 9:00am. If your child is late to school, there is a risk that they could miss the trip. We expect to return for the normal finish time of 3:10pm.

As we will be out all day we will be eating lunch at the Imperial War Museum, all children will need to bring a packed lunch and a bottle of water from home with them on the day of the trip. If your child is entitled to free school meals our school kitchen can provide your child with a free packed lunch. Please indicate on the return form if you require this. All children will need a bag to carry their lunch in.

All children must wear a warm coat with school uniform & school shoes.

We would greatly appreciate one or two parents per class to accompany us on the trip to the Imperial War Museum. If you would like to join us, please indicate this on the consent form attached.

In order for your child to be allowed to go to the Imperial War Museum please hand in the attached consent form to the school office. This must be signed by the parents/carers. Your child will not be able to go on the trip if we do not have written permission.
